Tuition Discount

Families with more than one student enrolled at Bethany qualify for 10% off tuition for the first child and 20% off tuition of the third and additional children.

Tuition Payment Plans

Bethany offers the following options for tuition payment:

1. Annual payment

- Due by July 15.

2. Semester payments

- Due by July 15 and December 15.
- Subject to a \$50 installment fee.

Other Cost Information

In addition to the tuition and fees listed above, students will need funds to cover personal spending and any incidentals they plan to purchase. International students are required to have proof of health insurance, which may be obtained through the student's company of choice.
